These key objectives will be achieved by:

- Ensuring that those responsible for Work Health and Safety uphold their role effectively and maintain relevant qualifications.
- Eliminate or control all work-related risks and hazards which could have an adverse effect on health and safety of DTS employees, and others.
- Make every employee of DTS responsible for creating and maintaining a safe work environment and that all employees are expected to observe safe work practices and procedures to ensure their own safety and that of their co-workers.
- Provide staff with the appropriate training to enable them to identify risks and hazards and how to implement control measures.
- Maintain a record of first aid injuries, lost-time injuries and medically-treated injuries.
- Ensure that Risk Assessments are completed prior to starting all jobs.
- Maintain all policies, procedures to maintain plant and equipment to ensure the safety of others.
- Encourages participation in the development of work, health and safety and continual improvement
